The King's Daily Bread

The king of a nation was the highest position in a nation. He was the head of authority, the chief decision maker, and the burden of the nation laid on the shoulders of the king. Due to his power as king, pride was a constant danger. Like Pharaoh and Caesar, the king could easily view himself as a god. Deuteronomy 17 gave laws and requirements for the future kings of Israel. Interestingly, the king was required to write for himself a copy of the law and to read it every day of his life. The purpose of reading the Law every day was so that the king would not be proud, thinking he was better than the citizens of the nation, and for him to learn to fear God.

The charge to the king for the daily reading of Scripture should apply to us as well. If you spend time in God's Word daily, you will witness the power of God, the wrath of God, the glory of God, and the love of God, in spectacular ways. You will be reminded of the awesomeness of God and the smallness of man and learn the fear of God. We are promised in Scripture that, "the fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom" (Proverbs 1:7). If you are tired of not living the holy life you are called to live, dive into Scripture and fear the Lord.
