

How Many Persons are in the Godhead?

Our Family Discipleship book asks the question, "How many persons are in the Godhead?" The answer is, "There are three persons in the Godhead: The Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit; and these three are one God, the same in substance, in power and glory."

The doctrine of the Trinity is one of the deepest and most profound doctrines to learn. Misunderstanding the Trinity results in huge consequences. For example, if one misunderstands the number of the persons in the Trinity, the result is that the distinction between the members is lost. For example, the Father is not the Son nor the Spirit; the Son is not the Father nor the Spirit; and the Spirit is not the Father nor the Son. Each of them is unique in their role. At the same time, the members of the Trinity are still one God. They are not three different gods, but are one God.

Understanding the Trinity requires a deep conviction that the words of the Bible are true. Each of the members of the Trinity are credited with being divine, and yet the Bible is adamant that there is one God. In understanding the Trinity, keep within the description of the Godhead as described within the pages of Scripture. When it come to teaching your family about the Trinity, keep this diagram in mind.
