
### The Christian's University

## Challenging God

There is a form of idolatry that lies within the hearts of most men, man's pride. For example, a man may have pride in his ability to make decisions, to go where he wants to go, and when he wants to go. There are lessons in Scripture that man would be wise to listen to: God displayed his power over Pharaoh (Exodus 1-12) and Jonah tried to run from God. Even some of the Proverbs remind us of God's power over man, "The plans of the heart belong to man, but the answer of the tongue is from the LORD." - Proverbs 16:1

There is no greater display of God's sovereignty over the individual than that of Nebuchadnezzar. Nebuchadnezzar could be influenced by no man. In the fourth chapter of Daniel, God reveals that no man is greater than God. God removed Nebuchadnezzar's sanity and caused him to eat, act and look like an animal. At the end of Nebuchadnezzar's seven year trial, he joyfully admitted, "Now I, Nebuchadnezzar, praise and extol and honor the King of heaven, for all his works are right and his ways are just; and those who walk in pride he is able to humble." - Daniel 4:37

God displays His power not only over great men like Nebuchadnezzar, Pharaoh and Jonah, but also over common people like you and I. If you have confessed Jesus Christ as Lord, you are evidence of this continued work (Ephesians 2:1-10, I Corinthians 2:14, Romans 12:3, Colossians 1:21-23). Today, give God praise for His work in your own conversion, having opened your eyes to His saving mercies.
