An Unlikely Family

The church is a strange organization. She is composed of all types of people: rich and poor, young and old, black and white, introvert and extrovert. One couldn't pick a more diverse group of people. You don't get to pick your parents, and you don't get to pick who goes to your church. Acts 2:47 says that the Lord adds to His church. Therefore, Southwest Christian Church is not a group of people who fit the same socio-economic status tier, but a people that the Lord has brought together, uniquely gifted, and built up for his own glory. I understand that when you look around the church on Sunday morning, there are people who are so culturally different from you, that you would never associate with them outside the church. But like God's love for you (though separated from Him by your sins, and dead in your trespasses), He has united a people who were formerly separated and made them one.

Since we have received God's great love, let us demonstrate that same love to each other. I John 4:7-8 says, "Beloved, let us love one another, for love is from God, and whoever loves has been born of God and knows God. Anyone who does not love does not know God, because God is love." Let us renew our commitment to one another by actively caring for those we worship with. You can demonstrate this love by caring for those in the church who are sick, visiting church members who are in the hospital, writing letters to fellow church members, and praying for one another.
